# Ordinance 21: Tobacco Retail Sales

## Licensee and sales-clerk education - Approved training

Licensed tobacco retailers ("licensees") must ensure that all sales-clerks complete a training program on the legal requirements related to the sale of licensed tobacco products and the possible consequences of license violations. Any training program must be pre-approved by Hennepin County.

#### Existing pre-approved training

Hennepin County has approved the "Stop Sales to Minors" online training program, available at https://www.stopsalestominors.org/login. The training is designed to help tobacco retailers comply with Hennepin County, state, and federal laws that regulate the sale of tobacco, electronic delivery devices, and tobacco-related devices and takes approximately one hour to complete. A review of the most recent Ordinance 21: Tobacco Retail Sales Licensee and Sales-Clerk Education Fact Sheet must also be completed.

### Other training

If a licensee chooses to provide a training program other than "Stop Sales to Minors," such alternate training programs must meet the following criteria to be considered pre-approved by Hennepin County:

- 1) Training program materials must cover the applicable federal, state, and local requirements, including updates to such requirements, that regulate the sale of Licensed Products, including but not limited to:
  - a) An overview of Licensed Products sold by the retailer;
  - b) Guidance on confirming proof of age to sell Licensed Products, with examples of sufficient proof of identification; and
  - c) An overview of the penalties associated with a violation of the applicable laws.
- 2) Training program materials may not be created, developed, or funded by the tobacco industry. Tobacco industry means manufacturers, distributors (i.e., businesses that sell products to a retailer), or wholesalers of Licensed Products (e.g., Juul, Altria, R.J. Reynolds). This includes parent companies and subsidiaries.
- 3) The training must include a review with employees of the most recent Hennepin County Ordinance 21: Tobacco Retail Sales Licensee and Sales Clerk Education Fact Sheet, provided to all licensees upon annual license renewal or approval of new license.
- 4) The training program must provide employees with proof or certification of completion.

Licensees must state at the time of renewal the training program being used. If at any time, Hennepin County determines that a licensee's alternate training program is not in compliance with any of the above criteria, the alternate training program will no longer be pre-approved.
