Virtual BINGO Instructions

Gather the following:

- BINGO cards with pictures or photographs of recyclable items on them
 - Advanced cards
 - Beginner cards
- BINGO caller instruction sheet
 - Advanced caller instruction sheet
 - o Beginner caller instruction sheet

Instructions

- Decide whether to advanced or beginner version of this game would be most appropriate for your participants. If the concept of recycling is new for participants, use the beginner set.
- 2. Distribute BINGO cards to all participants. This can be done by emailing one card to each participant before you meet, by sending one card to each participant when you meet, or by printing cards and distributing one each in student packets during pickup at your school/organization.
- 3. You will be the BINGO 'caller'
- 4. Confirm that each participant has a BINGO card and has a way of 'marking' items that are called off during the game.
- 5. Select an item from the caller card list, and mark that you have selected it, so you don't repeat yourself.
- 6. Caller describes the item to the players
 - a. Explain the material (plastic, paper, metal, etc.)
 - b. State the name of the item, as listed
- Players locate it on a card and cover with a bottle cap 'marker'
- 8. Caller continues to select and call out items until someone calls out BINGO
- 9. Consider giving virtual prizes to winners, like fun virtual backgrounds or other rewards as appropriate for your group.

Optional variations:

Try variations of BINGO, the caller can select to play regular BINGO, four corners, postage stamp or black out BINGO at the beginning of each game.
