The Ryan White system of care: HIV-related services and healthcare providers. The Ryan White Program at Hennepin County provides funding for HIV-related services and healthcare targeting low-income residents living with HIV across the 13-county metropolitan area, centered in Hennepin County. HIV care services allow people living with HIV to lead healthy, vibrant lives. These services also stop the virus from spreading.

Knowing your HIV status by getting tested is an important way to stay healthy and prevent new infections. Today's HIV test results are available in five minutes. For little or no cost, residents can access HIV testing at Hennepin County's <u>Red Door Clinic</u> or through primary care providers, community-based settings, private insurance, Medical Assistance, Medicare, and other public health insurance plans.
