



Vote early by mail



- Register to vote at mnvotes.gov
 - Register online **or**
 - Print a registration application **or**
 - Check if you're registered

- Apply to have an absentee ballot mailed to you
 - Online at mnvotes.gov/absentee
 - Return application by mail, fax or email to Hennepin County Elections

- Know what's on your ballot
 - View your sample ballot at mnvotes.gov/myballot

- Receive and fill out your ballot
 - Make sure to carefully read the instructions that come with your ballot
 - A witness signature is required from a registered voter or notary
 - You will get an additional registration form to fill out if you are not pre-registered

- Return ballot

By mail
Ballot needs to be received by Election Day to be counted

In-person
Drop off in person to your local election office no later than 8 p.m. on Election Day
