

CTG implementation awardee is required to assess these measures across the populations and among population subgroups, before and after the CTG implementation.

The CTG 5 Core Measures Primary Data Source for Adults

Baseline - SHAPE 2010 Adult Survey

(SHAPE 2006 Adult Survey for data by race and ethnicity)

- SHAPE stands for Survey of the Health of All the Population and the Environment.
- SHAPE 2010 was funded in part by a grant from the Minnesota Statewide Health Improvement Program.



SHAPE 2010 Adult Survey Domains and Topics

Overall health

- General health, health related quality of life
- Chronic disease and conditions
- Mental health
- Activity limitations, disabilities

Healthy lifestyle and behaviors

- Body weight, diet and nutrition
- Physical activity and exercise
- Neighborhood walkability & non-motorized transit use
- Smoking, alcohol use

Health care access & utilization

- Health insurance coverage
- Usual source of care
- Unmet health care need
- Preventive care & chronic disease risk behavior screening

Social-environmental factors


- Community connectedness, social support, neighborhood cohesion
- Neighborhood safety
- Discrimination experience
- Economic distress

Weight status - current status and disparities




Adult weight status¹




^{1.} Classification of body weight is based on body mass index (BMI) which was calculated from self-reported height and weight.

Adult obesity in 2010 How does Hennepin County compare?





Time trend 1998-2010, Hennepin County




Number of obese adults

Time trend 1998-2010, Hennepin County




Adult obesity by gender and age







Adult obesity by education and household income






Adult obesity by frequent mental distress and disability status








Adults total servings of fruits and vegetables consumed yesterday




Adults having 5-a-day by gender and age


Adults having 5-a-day by race and ethnicity







Q. During the past 30 days, other than your regular job, did you participate in any physical activity or exercises such as running, calisthenics, golf, gardening, or walking for exercise?


Adults engaging in NO leisure time physical activity by gender and age, Hennepin County 2010



Adults engaging in NO leisure time physical activity by race and ethnicity, Hennepin County 2006





Adults engaging in NO leisure time physical activity by education and household income



Adults engaging in NO leisure time physical activity by geographic areas, Hennepin County 2010










Time trend 1998-2010, Hennepin County




Number of adults who currently smoke Time trend 1998-2010, Hennepin County



Adults currently smoking in 2010 How does Hennepin County compare?




Adults currently smoking by gender and age Hennepin County 2010









Adult current smoking by housing type and household income, Hennepin County 2010




Adults currently smoking by frequent mental distress and LGBT identity




Adults mental health NOT good during the past 30 days Hennepin County 2010



Q. Thinking about your mental health, which includes stress, depression, and problems with emotions, for how many days during the <u>past 30 days</u> was your mental health not good?



Adults with frequent mental distress by race and ethnicity, Hennepin County 2006




Adults with frequent mental distress by education and household income




Adults aged 55 and older with frequent mental distress by disability status, Hennepin County 2010
